- **Operation School Bell:** Provides elementary students with new school clothing in the first few months of school. Space is limited. Please return this form as soon as possible!
- **School Supplies:** Additional support with necessary school supplies (notebook, pencils, backpacks, etc.)
- **Sightfest:** Assists eligible students with eye exam and free glasses (for uninsured students) all taken care of by district personnel.
